Green bottles will be provided. Tickets are to be securely fixed on all exhibits including each item in a collection. No entries accepted on the morning of the Show. Third prize if more than eight entries. Points awarded to 1st and 2nd prize only.

Growers to be within 100 km radius. If entries put in wrong section they will be disqualified.
